Longwood graduate programs (excluding Communication Sciences and Disorders)
cost \$396 per credit hour* (off campus) and \$499 per credit hour* (on campus/hybrid)

Communication Sciences and Disorders (Speech-Language Pathology)

54-56 credits - On Campus

You'll work closely with our faculty and clinical educators to gain the knowledge, training,
and skills necessary to practice as a speech language pathologist serving a diverse
population of adults and children in educational and healthcare settings.

Cost: \$533 per credit hour (in state)

FOR-CREDIT COURSES

Autism Spectrum Disorder Certificate

Hybrid (face-to-face & online)

Get the specialized skills you'll need to work as an instructor for this diverse population.

Learn about theory, a variety of evidence-based intervention methods, and working with families.

Eligibility: Bachelor's degree from regionally accredited institution and a minimum GPA of 2.75 or higher.

Cost: \$280 per credit hour for in-state residents / \$355 per credit hour for out-of-state residents

Educational Leadership Endorsement

Hybrid (face-to-face & online) | Cohorts begin each Fall

Prepares you for administrative and supervisory responsibilities, resource management, and program
planning and implementation. Successful completion of the courses meets eligibility requirements
for an endorsement in Administration and Supervision, PreK-12.

Cost: \$5,955 for in-state residents / \$7,530 for out-of-state residents

Licensure & Professional Development Courses

Fully Online

We offer many of the courses provisionally licensed teachers are required to complete for
full licensure at a reduced tuition rate. Before enrolling, check with the VDOE or your school division's
HR department to ensure the courses will meet your needs.

Cost: \$280 per credit for in-state residents / \$355 per credit hour for out-of-state residents

SLP Online (Speech-Language Pathology Prerequisites)

Fully Online

These online courses are the prerequisites most commonly required for application to a master's program
in Speech-Language Pathology. We offer these courses each semester at a reduced tuition rate.

Cost: \$280 per credit hour for in-state residents / \$355 per credit hour for out-of-state residents

NON-CREDIT CLASSES

Earn recertification points for as little as \$99 per class in a convenient four-week online format. Classes cover
a variety of topics and are offered year-round. Most classes are suggested for 30 recertification points.

Cost: As low as \$99/class
